Our Vision

"Let Your Light Shine" – we help every child to grow in confidence, kindness and respect. Everyone has the right to feel safe all the time.

Our Core Expectations

- Be Ready – arrive on time, prepared for learning.
- Be Respectful – show kindness, use polite language, follow instructions.
- Be Safe – move calmly, keep hands/feet/objects to yourself.

How We Support Positive Behaviour

- Warm, consistent relationships with staff.
- Praise for effort, kindness and positive choices.
- House points and whole-class celebrations.
- Restorative conversations to help children repair and move forward.

If Behaviour Goes Wrong

We use a simple stepped approach:

1. Private reminder.
2. Clear choice and support.
3. Final reminder.

→ If behaviour continues, a short time away from class with an adult (removal).

A brief restorative chat helps the child return positively.

Working with Families

We will contact you if patterns of behaviour occur: *Please acknowledge receipt of letters.*

- 3 missed breaks with headteacher – Letter 1.
- 6 missed breaks with headteacher – Letter 2 + meeting.
- 9 missed breaks with headteacher – Letter 3 + weekly report card.

Serious Incidents

For unsafe or harmful behaviour, senior staff become involved immediately. We always prioritise safety and follow national safeguarding guidance.

How You Can Help

- Talk positively about school expectations.
- Encourage good routines – sleep, organisation, kindness.
- Let us know early if something is affecting your child.
