Dear parents/carers,

On 30th June we were inspected under section 48 of the Education Act – SIAMS – Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools. This inspection takes place every 4/5 years, however we were very behind (having our last one in 2015) due to COVID.

I am pleased to report that the inspection found us to be excellent. Excellent overall and excellent for the impact of collective worship. This is the highest grading which can be achieved by a Church School, and is even more significant as the inspection framework changes from September 2023, to an ungraded judgement.

The inspection recognised how we have developed our school vision to be all encompassing in everything we do. *"The school's vision has a strikingly normal, life-changing and transformational impact on the lives of pupils and adults"*.

The report especially highlights our approach to 'forgiveness and reconciliation', ensuring that we treat children differently in order to treat them equally. It also showcases how we welcome children and families from a diverse range of backgrounds.

"The 'shine' values and behaviour code actively encourage them to develop forgiveness and reconciliation. The consistent use of this language ensures that the Christian vision remains at the centre of behaviour management. Pupils feel safe and confident as a direct result of these values. They understand and appreciate the importance of the behaviour code. Pupils display an unquestioning acceptance of diversity in all its forms, ensuring that all are included and welcomed".
