Our learning...	This week, it has been all about fireworks and poppies. We have been using a lot of glitter to create pictures, we coloured by numbers, we wrote some words to describe fireworks, we added a bonfire to our role play corner. We have been learning all about Remembrance Day and the significance of poppies. We painted and coloured in poppy pictures, went on a poppy hunt outside and ordered poppies into sizes. We will continue to do PE on a Thursday, we started our gymnastics learning and we learnt how to move and travel across the mats in different ways. At forest school, we had a lot of fun exploring the pile of wood chippings.
Phonics	This week we introduced new sounds – ss and then we reviewed all the previous sounds. In class we have read 'Magnus is stuck' & Get the duck.
Maths	We have been focussing on 4 & 5. We have counted, sorted and matched a variety of objects. We also used our shape knowledge to make some rockets.
