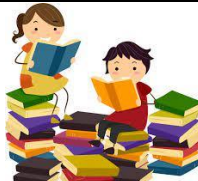
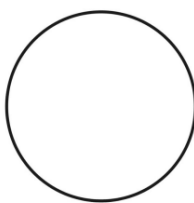
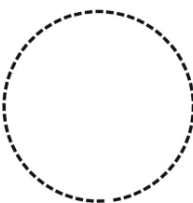


Week 4 – 26.11.23 to 1.12.23
