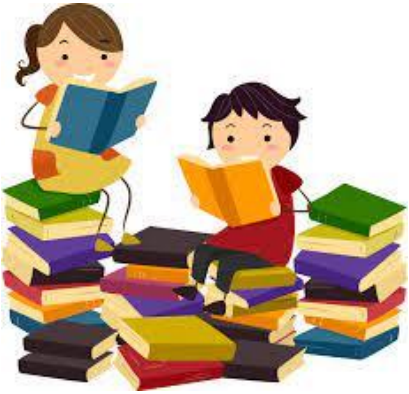


Week 2 –15.1.24 – 19.1.24

We made owls using sticks we collected on our walks around school. In P.E. we have been playing lots of different games and moving in different ways.
