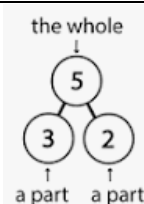
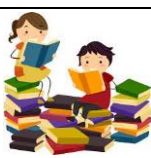


Week 3 –22.1.24 – 26.1.24

Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
Our learning...	Continuing our theme of People who help us, we had 2 visitors to our classroom. Mrs Rotherham works at Myton hospice, she shared with us how she helps the people in her care; we particularly liked her purple uniform. Simon is a paramedic; he told us all about his job and showed us how to apply bandages. The children also watched a video of Mrs Hancock friend's farm and they made a list of questions to ask farmer Sam. We have been learning all about questions and what questions are and we looked at question marks. In the classroom, we labelled a farm, made our own farms, counted ducks in the water, explored the weighing scales and had some bricks with pretend cement. We made bird cakes for the birds (must to the frustration of the children who thought we were making bird cakes for ourselves!) and took them out whilst at forest school. We have set up the camera to see what eats them. We made thank you chocolate for people who have visited us and for people in our homes that we wanted to thank.
Phonics	We have revisited all the sounds we have learnt. We have been focusing on sh, th, ng and nk. We read Moths & Tigers fish.
Maths	We have been learning how 2 parts make a whole. E.g. $3+2=5$ 
Home learning	 Please log onto your Oxford Owl and share the books on there. Please talk to the children about your jobs and jobs different people in your family do and encourage your children to ask questions. 
Next week	We are walking to the library on Tuesday afternoon. We have got the firefighters coming to talk to us on Wednesday - This is dependant on whether they are free and don't have a 999 call. On Friday, it is NSPCC Maths day, please could the children bring in some copper coins.
