Our learning...	This week, we have been making boats and seeing how many toy animals it took to sink them, writing sentences about Farmer Duck, eating buffalo ice cream and counting birds. On Monday, the children had their eye test. We had fun at the library on Tuesday, lots of children showed an interest in joining. Please do go along and join, it is free. We learnt all about the books, had a tour and the librarians read us some stories. The firefighters were planning to pop and see us on Wednesday, but they got a call out.
