Our learning...	 This term we have started our new topic Ready Steady Grow. We shared the story The tiny seed by Eric Carle. In class, we have written about our week off, painted flowers, made playdough worms, weeded the allotment and brought some frogspawn into the classroom from our pond. We love watching and saying hello to the frogspawn and cannot wait to watch what happens. We planted some beans in groups and learnt some new words all about growing including germinate, shoot, seedling, roots, stem and we ordered the bean life cycle.
Phonics	We have introduced some new sounds this week – oo, ar & ur. We read the book We can cook and Little Blending Book 10. We have been reading and writing sentences in phonics.
Maths	We have been learning about length & height. We used the book Superworm to help us with longer than / shorter than. We compared bits of wool and ordered them by length. We learnt all about height and how things can be taller or shorter.
