Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
Our learning...	This week, we have created flowers, houses and scarecrows. We enjoyed a RockSteady music session. At forest school, we enjoyed exploring the fallen down trees. We learnt about how to plant seeds and what plants need to grow. In PE, we have started our dance unit and we have been moving like different animals and we have tried to put a sequence of animal's moves together to create a short animal dance.
Phonics	We have introduced some new sounds this week – oo, or & ow We read the book "Popcorn Surfing", "Stuck in the mud" & "Turnip is missing." We have been reading and writing sentences in phonics.
Maths	We have been learning about time and days of the week. We have been singing the days of the week and months of the year song. We have sorted activities that we do into the morning, afternoon and evening. We used a variety of timers and timed how long it took us to do some things. E.g. In 1 minute, how many jumps could we do.
Home learning	Please log onto your Oxford Owl and share the books on there. We have been looking at baby pictures and trying to guess which adult the baby is. You could share baby pictures together of different members of your family and talk about how your child has grown up.
