Our learning...	This week we have been using 'The Rainbow fish' to guide our learning. We talked about the book, predicted the story, read the story, wrote about rainbow fish and used collage to make our own fish. We have really enjoyed exploring our new under the sea role play area. Outside, we have enjoyed making snail houses and using the tyres to make our own houses.
Phonics	We have been re-visiting the sounds we find tricky and reading words with them in. We have also been writing captions for pictures. We read the books - Helter-skelter & A shock for Nok.
Maths	This week, we have been learning all about odd / even numbers and doubling numbers. We used the story Bean Thirteen by Matthew McElligott to help. We also used an online game – https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/coconut-odd-or-even We have been finding number bonds to 10, these are the numbers that added together equal 10 for example $5 + 5 = 10$, $6 + 4 = 10$, $7 + 3 = 10$.
