Our learning...	This week, we have been busy writing more captions and sentences. The children have enjoyed painting different pictures, exploring with small beads and making stick puppets. We enjoyed watching Mike do some BMX tricks on Wednesday. We created giant bubbles in the outside area. On Thursday, we joined in the whole school sustainability day and we learnt ways that we can look after our planet Earth. We planted sunflowers and thought about what plants need to grow and we made perfume using water and exploring our school grounds to find flowers and things to create our perfume.
Phonics	We have been reviewing all the phonics that we have learnt. Playing phonic games and writing captions.
Maths	This week, we have been learning about positions. We used the book 'We're going on a bear hunt' to help with our learning. We went around the classroom placing our toys in different positions.
Home learning	 Please log onto your Oxford Owl and share the books on there. Please draw or write or take a photograph and stick in on the next page of what something you can do at home to look after the planet – picking up rubbish, turning off water when brushing our teeth, recycling...
