Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
In the Classroom...	This week, our Maths theme has been sizes. We have been making different sized junk models, painting long strokes & short strokes, building tall and short lego models, finding heavy things and lights things. Whilst practising our cutting skills, we cut out and sorted the furniture the 3 bears needed. After collecting the squashes from the allotment; we made our own squash soup. We have been learning all about mass and comparing mass and finding out which is heavier and lighter using the scales.
Outside the classroom...	The size theme continued outside, whilst weeding the gardens we talked about the size of the weeds and collected a variety of worms. Sienna managed to find the longest worm! We collected squashes from the allotment and went down to the orchard to collect more apples. We also enjoyed watching the night camera we have installed. We now know we have a fox coming onto our field.
Phonics	This week, we have introduced the sounds i, n, m, and d. We have continued to learn how to sound out (segment) using our robot arms and blend the sounds to make the word. We have read Splat! The Little Blending Book and Pip's Prank.
