In the Classroom...	This week, we used the book 'Peace at last' to guide our learning. We made 2D shape bears, wrote a list of who lives in our house, had brown playdough to make bears, had coloured water and recreated the story using props. We wrote a list of who lives in our house and we have been writing our names everywhere! We sorted pictures into day and night time.
Outside the classroom...	It was chalk week, apologies for those children who came home covered in chalk! We made patterns, coloured bricks, wrote letters and numbers all over our outside area. Whilst at forest school, for those children that might have said, Mrs Hancock did push down one of the small willow trees. We then enjoyed using the saw to make smaller pieces for us to use.
Phonics	This week we introduced new sounds – g,c,o & k. We have continued to sound out and blend words together using all of our sounds.
Maths	We have been learning to subitise. This means being able to look at a small number of objects and instantly recognise how many objects there are without needing to count.
