In the Classroom...	This week, it has been all about Remembrance and kindness. We started the week focusing on remembrance and making poppies. Nationally, this week is Anti-bullying week so we have focused our attention on being kind. We discussed how we could be kind and watched a video that gave us some ideas. On our creative table, we decorated stones and made flowers to give to people. We made each other cards, handed out stickers and made a list of all the kind things we did. We thought about our friends and how we are all kind. We also learnt about the Children in need charity and how they help children. We have started going to the hall to practise our play. We are sending home the songs words to practice today and we will send home any words for individual children to learn next week. Thank you for helping us, we are looking forward to performing "our Wiggly Nativity" to you.
Outside the classroom...	We had fun sweeping all the leaves in our area, playing superhero games and making different paths for our friends to follow. At forest school, we enjoyed wrapping string / wool around the trees and decorating the den.
Phonics	We introduced new sounds 'j, v, w, = & x' . We read the stories 'An odd bug'.
Maths	We continued subitising numbers to 5 and we have learnt how to represent 4 and 5 in different ways for example - 4 can be made of $2 + 2 = 4$, $3 + 1 = 4$, $4 + 0 = 4$.
Home learning	Please can you practise singing the play songs.
