Our learning...	This week we have been; using the playdough to make birthday cakes, making emergency vehicles with our junk modelling bits, making lanyards for our role play areas, creating obstacle courses outside and writing about what we want to be when we're grown up. On Wednesday, we enjoyed listening to Sam, the physiotherapist, and enjoyed our Drumba workout. On Thursday, Mr Stacey came in to talk about his jobs, he has 5 different jobs at school and he showed us different tools he uses. In P.E. we have been learning all about moving on different levels – high, medium and low by being different animals and we created a sequence putting all the animal movements together. On Friday, we are hoping that the Fire Service will be able to visit us and talk about their job.
Phonics	We have continued to practise the digraphs 'nk, ng, th, ch, sh'. We have also been learning the names of the letters. We used Rosie's phonic game to create words.
Maths	We have been embedding our knowledge of numbers to 5. We have used the book "Ugly 5" to help with our learning. We used a crocodile and a snowman rhyme to help with more than / less than. We have been counting and we ordered our numbers to 10.
