We enjoyed making and then eating apple crumble using some of the apples we picked. We have been learning all about our school value SHINE and how we let our light shine. Our school values are SHINE – Safe, Honest, Include, kiNd and rEspect. We have been sharing toys with our friends and playing games with our friends. We have enjoyed role playing in the kitchen and building train tracks.
Phonics	We have started learning our new sounds which will help us to learn how to read and write. We have started to learn how to write these letters.
Maths	We have been matching and sorting objects into different groups.

We enjoyed going to forest school and loved searching the minibeads and swinging on the forest school swing. We will now be regularly going to forest school on a Wednesday afternoon.
