Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
In the Classroom...	This week, we have enjoyed the book 'Owl Babies'. We have made owls with shapes, colouring owl pictures, re-telling the story, looking at what the characters are saying and sequencing the story. We have also enjoyed using the telephones (old) in the room, singing 10 speckled frogs in the water and playing with the dolls house. On Thursday, it was whole school poetry day and we read lots of different poems. We started to think about the seasons and autumn and what happens in autumn.
Outside the classroom...	We enjoyed getting the bats and balls out and making an obstacle course. Whilst at forest school, we had our usual fun; making muddy puddles and swinging in the trees.
Phonics	This week, we have practised s,a,t,p, m, n, d & i. We sorted objects and blended the letters together to make new words. We have been segmenting (sounding out) the sounds in words to spell words when writing.
Maths	We have used the stories 'It's my teddy' and 'Blue Balloon' to help with our learning about size and weight. We have been ordering objects by size. We have been thinking about weight and what objects are heavier or lighter than other objects.
P.E.	We have started P.E. and playing games in the hall. On Thursday, please send your child into school wearing their PE clothes – plain white t-shirt, plain black shorts or jogging bottoms, School PE hoodie or plain black one and trainers. Thank you.
Home learning	If the weather is nice, please explore the change of season and the children can bring in any leaves, fir cones, conkers or autumn things into school to explore.
