In the Classroom...	This week, we have read the story 'Peace at last' and made a list of all the people that live in our houses. We have worked our way through our Protective Behaviours scheme; the children have discussed how to keep safe. On Thursday, we celebrated Black History day by looking at the artwork of Alma Thomas and playing the traffic light game in PE. We learnt that Garrett Morgan invented the traffic light. We are very proud of everyone, they have all settled in well into the Reception class and our school.
Outside the classroom...	We created a new swing in our outside area. At forest school, we enjoyed playing "What's the time Mr Wolf?" and using the space hoppers. We also had fun making faces with big googly eyes and making 'mud' cement.
Phonics	We introduced the digraph 'ss' and reviewed the sounds we have learnt throughout the term.
Maths	We began the week sharing the story 3 Billy Goats Gruff and looking at different ways of making 3. Then we ended the week learning about circles and triangles.
