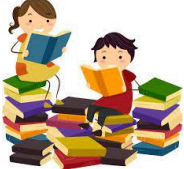


Spring 2 Week 1 – 24.2.25 – 28.2.25

Please find below the summary of our week in school.									
Our learning...	This week we have been focussing on being a good friend. We have read lots of stories about friendship and listened to a song Be nice song. In the classroom, we enjoyed painting, making the train track, building towers and playing with the little ponies. We independently wrote the rhyme Humpty Dumpty and enjoyed making long / short playdough worms. We found the longest and shortest caterpillars. We read lots of stories by Oliver Jeffers and enjoyed playing with our new rocket and making our own rockets from junk modelling. Forest school was a story of 2 halves. 1 half got muddy and the other half had an adventure through the orchard being chased by the wolf (aka Callum). During PE, we were learning how to dodge and we played lots of dodging games. We practised our ball skills and were rolling, throwing, catching and bouncing the ball to our partner.								
Phonics	We have learnt some new sounds – or & ow. We read the book "We can cook" and Blending book 10. We have been writing lots of words and captions by sounding out the words and writing the sounds we can hear.								
Maths	We have been looking at sizes – long, short, tall and small. We have found objects and we have compared objects. We have been thinking about time and looking at what we can do in 1 minute.
