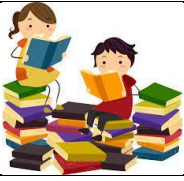


Home learning Spring 2 Week 5– 22.3.25 –28.3.25

We have written how to plant a bean, talked about how seeds travel, used junk modelling to create beanstalks / flowers and created Mother's Day cards. We had a very enjoyable visit to the library. The lady showed the children what the library has to offer and how to borrow books. It is definitely worth a visit! We borrowed some books to read back at school. The children were so well behaved, the librarian said they were the best class who has visited and they all sat so beautifully. We are very proud of them. They gave us a book colouring sheet for everyone. At forest school, we enjoyed exploring the new dens that Mr Taylor created for us, had fun with the teddies and bounced on the space hoppers. We made vegetable soup, using knives carefully, we cut potatoes, leeks, parsnips and carrots and we enjoyed eating it as well. We used the new Drumba drums and we enjoyed the Drumba workout in PE.
Phonics	We have learnt the new sounds 'ure, ow & er' and read the story 'The lost cow' and "The Rocket Flight."
Maths	We have continued looking at how to make 10, making it with 2 parts & 3 parts. We have also looked at doubling numbers to 10. We also thought about odd and even numbers.
