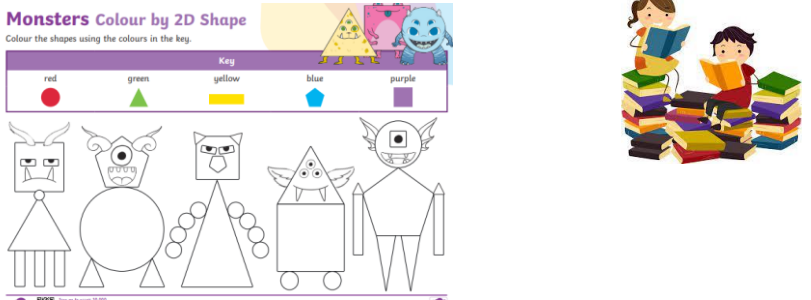


Home learning Spring 2 Week 6– 31.3.25 –4.4.25

Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
Our learning...	This week, we have used the rhyme “Dingle Dangle Scarecrow” to guide our learning. We tried to make a scarecrow to protect our beans, we decorated old CD’s to hang up around the allotment and we made some odd / even monsters. At forest school, we made some very muddy potions, moved the pallets to be able to climb up more trees and went over to the allotment to plant our beans. We learnt all about the different parts of a plant and labelled a plant.
Phonics	We have been practising the sounds we know using our read and write sheets. We have been thinking about the different sounds in words and we have written sentences. We read the “Bat facts”.
Maths	This week, we have been learning about 3D shapes. We have found the 2D shape that is inside a 3D shape. We made shapes with our bodies. We painted with 3D shapes and made pictures with the shapes. We painted castles, houses, motorbikes and more!
Home learning	Please name the 2D shapes and colour in the shape monsters. Please read your reading books, please can we ask you to return the books weekly so we can change them. Thank you
