Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
English	We have started our new book, 'Beegu'. This week, we made predictions about what we think the story will be about, used speech bubbles and question marks to infer how the character is feeling, and we used adjectives to describe a setting (Beegu's home). We will continue learning this text of Beegu next week.
Maths	This week, we have continued to look at addition and subtraction number problems. We have used the part-whole model to find missing information. Also, we have explored subtraction - find a part, fact families - the eight facts, subtraction - take away/cross out (How many left?) We will continue learning addition and subtraction next week.
Science	We have started our new topic 'everyday materials'. This week, we have been gathering and recording information about what we already know about materials and what we would like to find out. Next week, we will continue learning about everyday materials.
