English	This week, we have continued with the book called 'The Emperor's Egg.' This week, the children are learning about a non-chronological report. They have looked at the features and planned what they will use for their report. Next week, we will be rewriting the story.
Maths	We have continued learning the topic of 'place value within 20.' We have been understanding numbers up to 20. We have been using ten frames to make the numbers. Using the stem sentences - 14 has 1 ten and 4 ones. Next week, we will continue learning place value.
Science	Our theme is animals, including humans. This week, we were learning all about comparing animals and thinking about what is the same and different in the various groups of animals. Next week we will continue learning about animals, including humans.
