Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
English	This week, we concluded with the book The Emperor's Egg. The children wrote a non-chronological report, following the plans and adding details. Next week, we will be starting a new book.
Maths	We have continued learning 'place value within 20.' We have been understanding numbers up to 20. The children have been learning 1 more and 1 less, using a numberline, estimating on a numberline to 20, comparing numbers to 20, and ordering numbers to 20. Next week, we will continue learning about place value.
Science	Our theme is animals, including humans. This week, we explained what herbivores, omnivores, and carnivores eat. We identified what different animals eat and sorted animals into the diet groups they belong to. Next week we will continue learning about animals, including humans.
