Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
Our learning...	On Monday, we welcomed everyone back from Easter and had a lovely day sharing our holiday stories. On Tuesday, we used the story Poo in the zoo to introduce our new theme 'Amazing animals' for this term. Some of us enjoyed looking through poo (playdough with coffee in) to see if it came from a carnivore, herbivore or omnivore. In the classroom, we have been writing about our favourite animal and why we liked that animal. On Thursday, we had Art day where we made a giant tree with animals in it, like "Art Attack." We used pastels to draw different animals, looking closely at the colours and features of the different animals.
Phonics	We have been practising all of our sounds. We have been saying words, joining (blending) them and then writing them. We have been writing reading and writing sentences.
Maths	This week, we have been focussing on counting to 20. We have been building numbers, looking at patterns in numbers and matching numerals to pictures. We ordered numbers to 20.
Home learning	Talk to your family and friends about their favourite animals and why they like them. Practise your reading and share your reading book.
