Our learning...	On Tuesday, we enjoyed an introduction to All-star cricket. The children had a session with cricket coach, who gave us leaflets to the nearest club. This week, we have read the traditional story "The Three Little Pigs", we used the puppets to act out our own versions and sequenced the story on a story map. We huffed and puffed with some paint, using straws to create a picture. We made piggy houses in the tuft tray. We have started to write the story of the three little pigs. Also, this week, we have been thinking about all the things that we love to learn and do in Reception, getting ready for our class assembly next week. Out at forest school, we took some pens to draw fairy doors on the trees. The biggest excitement / shock came as we found a dead bird! We tried to dig a hole, however the soil was too hard so we had to take it into the pond area and bury it there. We had Mr Clarke (our sports coach) teach us lots of different games in PE and we have been practising our races ready for sports day.
