Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
Our learning...	This week, we have enjoyed learning all about bees! Thank you for letting your children dress up, they all enjoyed it. We did a variety of bee activities – colouring, counting, painting, collaging, matching bees and making honey biscuits! At forest school, we tried to find some bees and make some bee hotels. We finished our amazing stories all about the three little pigs, we have written the whole story over the last few weeks. We have read lots of stories and we read as a group, talking about all the parts of the books, including the title, front cover, back cover, blurb and we talked all about the author and illustrator. We enjoyed creating an ice-cream shop and under the sea book area ready for next half term.
Phonics	We have been reviewing all the sounds we've learnt and looking at the tricky (harder to read and spell) words. We have read Test it and the Big Picture. We have been focusing on letter formation.
Maths	This week, we have been subtracting. We have written a number sentence to go with the number story. We have been learning all about shapes, shape names and how to make pictures using shapes and rotating shapes so they fit in the pictures.
Home learning	Please practising writing your letters and numbers, remembering where to start from.
Next half term!	Our learning for the last half term in Reception will be "Under the Sea". We will be using the books Rainbow fish, Tiddler and Tropical Terry to guide our learning. Forest School will continue to be on Wednesday. PE will swap to a Tuesday. For this half term, Mrs Francis will be in class Monday & Tuesday. Mrs Hancock will be in class Wednesday to Friday.
