Please find below the summary of our week in school.		
English	This week, we have concluded with The Rabbit Problem book. The children have written an informal letter to a farmer, stating their viewpoint on helping the farmer. We have also sequenced and rewritten the Easter story. After Easter, we are going to start a new book.	
Maths	This week, we started a new topic, 'Mass and volume' and concluded the topic. We measured volume, compared capacity, and completed the end-of-block assessment. After Easter, we will start a new topic.	
Science	We have concluded with the theme 'animals including humans.' This week, the children completed the end-of-unit assessment. We will start a new topic after Easter.	
DT	The children have created a garden using cardboard boxes. The children looked at what they might see in a garden. They were inspired by a designer, Robert Sayer's 1765 invention, known as "lift-the-flap" books. They made their garden to have a 3D effect. The children have worked hard in making their plans and designing and making their garden.
