

Week beginning 9.10.2023

Please find below the summary of our week in school.		
English	In the coming weeks we will continue with the book 'The Bee Who Spoke'. This week the children have explored a character through role play, and listed items that they would put in their backpack for an adventure.	
Maths	We have started our new topic of 'Addition and subtraction within 10'. This week the children have been introduced to part-whole models and fact families (for example $4+2=6$, $2+4=6$, $6=4+2$ and $6=2+4$). Following on from this, the children created number sentences.	
Science	We have continued learning all about the four seasons. This week we are looking at seasonal changes and observing scientifically. We have created charts to measure the date, weather, temperature and rainfall. Next week we will evaluate our results.	
Geography	Our theme is 'how does the weather affect our lives'? The children have been identifying and locating hot and cold areas of the worlds. We have looked at the equator, and discussed how it affects the temperature of countries closest to it. Furthermore, the children have explored temperatures in the North and South Poles.
