Please find below the summary of our week in school.		
English	The children have completed the book 'The Bee Who Spoke'. To conclude this half term the children have written their own narrative independently.	
Maths	'Addition and subtraction within 10'. This week the children have been doing addition by adding together, adding one more, and addition problems (for example, $4 + 1 = 5$, $_ + 5 = 8$ and $2 + _ = 10$ and so forth). The children have used mathematical language (first there is 2 then 4 more and now there is 6). The children used ten frames and counters to do a practical lesson.	
Science	This week the children have written what they have learned about the four seasons, recapping from all the learning they have done this half term. We will be starting a new topic after half term.	
Geography	We have finished learning our theme on 'how does the weather affect our lives?' This week the children have written about what they have learned in geography recapping from all the learning they have done this half term. After half term we will be learning History.
