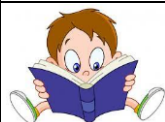

Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
English	On Monday, our spelling lesson introduced us to challenging words. This week, we have been entertaining ourselves in English by creating a short narrative about a customer's strange order. We broke it up into 3 sections – the beginning, the middle and the end.
Maths	We have been using our learning of adding / subtracting to solve problems. We have been looking at the inverse operations.
Other subjects	In Science, we conducted a magnet investigation. We had to make a paper clip move. We explored the classroom finding objects that were magnetic. In RE, we talked about different buildings representing different beliefs and then we used the lego to make our own construction. Instead of going to Forest school, we went to the allotment and picked the carrots to eat. We also did some orienteering. In Art, we painted our own version of a David Hockney picture. In Spanish, we learnt the months of the year.
