



Welcome to our home school communication! Each week you will get an overview of the class learning and will be set some home tasks too. The children will have spellings, which will be tested on a Monday, times tables practise and reading. Home school communication books should be returned to school on a Wednesday.

Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
English	This week our spelling rule is 'ture' making a 'chuh' sound. In English, we have planned and written Max's next adventure.
Maths	We have been comparing and ordering numbers. We have been counting in 50's, spotting the patterns.
Science	This week, we have been talking about fossils. We have sequenced the fossilisation process using pictures.
Other subjects	We have finished our protective behaviours program with identifying adults we are happy to talk to. In Re, we looked through a variety of prayers and found references to nature. Out at forest school, we saw a buzzard sat on the goal posts. It flew off into the trees. We had fun using the apples and mud in the mud kitchen. On Thursday, we went to the church for our harvest festival service. All the children behaved beautifully in church.
