Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
English	This week, we have a new book 'Prince Cinders.' The children have written a prediction of what they thought the book could be about, who might the characters be? The children wrote an inference and sequenced the story. Also, they have been learning what proper nouns and common nouns are.
Maths	We have started a new topic of 'Multiplication and division.' This week the children have been counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s. They recognised equal groups, added equal groups and made arrays.
Geography	We have continued with our new theme 'Why does it matter where my food comes from?' This week we have been learning about how cheese is made.
Science	We have continued with our new theme 'plants'. The children identified and named some common garden and wild plants. We looked in our school grounds for some wild plants and in the allotment for some garden plants.
