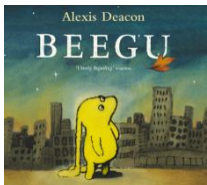


Week beginning 13.11.2023

English 	We have continued with the book, 'Beegu'. This week we have explored a character's thoughts and feelings, created and described a character using adjectives. Also, we have produced a 'Lost' poster of Beegu adding labels and a short paragraph using a range of adjectives.
Maths  $\begin{array}{l} 5 + 2 = 7 \\ 7 = 5 + 2 \\ 2 + 5 = 7 \\ 7 = 2 + 5 \end{array}$ $\begin{array}{l} 7 - 5 = 2 \\ 2 = 7 - 5 \\ 7 - 2 = 5 \\ 5 = 7 - 2 \end{array}$ Complete the fact family. Could you have done it a different way?	This week we have continued to look at addition and subtraction number problems. We have explored subtraction - find a part, fact families - the eight facts, subtraction - take away/cross out (How many left?)
