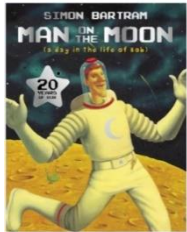
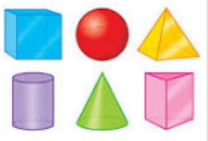


Week beginning 4.12.2023

English 	We have continued with the book, 'Man on The Moon'. This week the children have explored a range of advertisement posters and identified the features of these.
