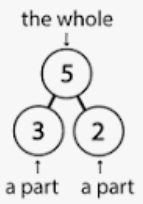


Week 3 – 19.1.25-23.1.25

Please find below the summary of our week in school.		
Our learning...	This week we have been focusing on how people in school help us and we wrote about how Mrs Timson, Mrs Byard and Mrs Jones help us. We read a story about vets and talked about how vets help us. We watched some videos of different people who help us. On Tuesday, it was Penguin awareness day, we learnt all about penguins, we played with our penguin and snow tuff tray and we made penguins. On Tuesday, Road Safety Sallie came in to talk about road safety and we learnt how to follow the road safety code. In the classroom; we have loved playing schools, making cakes in the playdough, being Doctors and we explored the weighing scales. At forest school, we enjoyed playing in the dens, swinging and exploring the tyres.	
Phonics	We have continued identifying the letter names and the sounds they make. We read the story 'Moths' spotting the digraphs as we read. We have been reading lots of our harder to read and spell words including no, and, to, the, into.	
Maths		We have been learning how 2 parts make a whole. E.g. $3+2=5$ We also have begun exploring weighing. We have had the weighing scales out and have been balancing objects, learning all about the mass of an object and how cubes it weighs.
