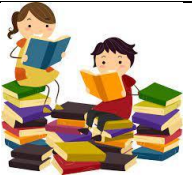


Week 6 – 9.2.26 – 13.2.26

Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
Our learning...	This week we have been focusing on how people help us and Chinese / Lunar new year. We have been celebrating Chinese / Lunar new Year and we learnt all about how people celebrate. We made lanterns, and special red envelopes. We enjoyed trying lots of food including spring rolls, noodles, rice, prawn crackers and fortune cookies. We made our own dragon head and moved like the dragon dance outside. On Tuesday, it was safer internet day and we helped Smartie the penguin to be safe online by singing the song – Before you tap and click, You need to stop and think, and tell someone. On Wednesday, we had two Police officers and a PCSO visit us and told us all about their job. They also talked to us about never ever going with people we don't know.
Phonics	We have continued identifying the letter names and the sounds they make. We read the story 'Duckbot' spotting the digraphs as we read. We have been reading lots of our harder to read and spell words and talking about the story and what happened.
Maths	We have learnt all about addition and combining two groups together. We explored and compared lengths of objects and used the language long, longer than, short and shorter than.
