Please find below the summary of our week in school.	
In the Classroom...	This week the children have focused on nursery rhymes as part of National Nursery Rhyme Week, the songs we have been singing are – Sing a song of sixpence, Humpty Dumpty, When I was one, I hear thunder and Two little dickie birds. We enjoyed singing the songs and looking for different versions of the songs. We have continued to practise our Nativity show. On Tuesday, we joined in with Remembrance Day and held a minute silence and painted our own poppies. On Wednesday, we went to the scooter day assembly and watched some fantastic tricks! On Friday, we found out all about Children in need and Pudsey bear.
Outside the classroom...	At forest school the children have had lots of fun playing with the leaves, riding bikes, playing with the snakes and dinosaurs and they have been playing the traffic light game.
Phonics	This week we have learnt new sounds v, w, x and j. Our new harder to read and spell words are he , she and buses . The children have also been identifying capital letters and full stops.
Maths	In Maths, we have been learning all about the composition of numbers and how this means what the numbers are made of, for example 3 is a part and 2 is a part, 5 is the whole. We have been counting lots of things.
Home learning	Please continue to practise the song words for the Nativity, thank you. Please read and practise your sounds and words. Practise writing the letters j, v, w and x. Remember to hold your pencil like a tripod.  Please can you trace and write the letters – j, v, w and x.
